Event Area	The event takes place in the town of Ebeltoft. The embargoed area can be found here: http://okpan.dk/dmsprint2023/skovlukning.html . The area is strictly embargoed but it is allowed to follow the marked green road at the west border of the embargoed area.
Map	Ebeltoft By, 1:4.000, contour interval 2.5 m, ISSprOM 2019-2, drawn in 2023 by Kell Sønnichsen.
Terrain	Ebeltoft is a small town with cobblestones, small backyards, and narrow streets. The competition area also includes green spots and residential areas. The town is placed on a slope with a max. altitude difference of 25 m. There will be some traffic in the competition area and there might be many people in the pedestrian streets. Ebeltoft is a popular tourist destination during the summer months.

Punching system	SPORTident Air+ (touch free). Using a SIAC card would be an advantage. If you wish to use your own SI-card, you should indicate the card number in the registration. If no SI-card number is given in the registration, a card will automatically be rented with a price of 30 DKK. A limited number of SIAC cards is available for renting.
Start	Individual start with a 1 min start interval. First start will be at 2pm for the elite classes (M/W18, M/W20 and M/W21). The distance from the event arena to the start is approx. 1000 m.
Spectators	Spectators are allowed along the course. Participants in the event will however be excluded from this rule.
Travel	Ebeltoft can be reached by public transport from all the greater cities

information	in the area (Aarhus, Randers, Grenå). You can plan your journey at www.rejseplanen.dk If you arrive by car a parking area will be allocated for the event participants and spectators. Follow the signs. The distance from the parking area to the event arena will be 100-1500 m.
Food and beverages	A limited selection of food and beverages can be found in a small kiosk at the event arena.
